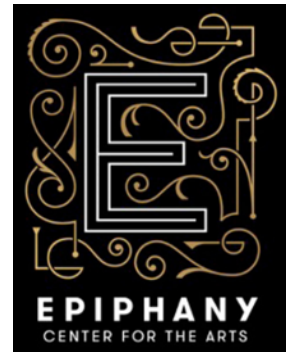

EPIPHANY ARTS CENTER ANNOUNCES AN EXHIBITION OF WORKS BY KATHY WEAVER

Epiphany Arts Center is excited to welcome the public to an exhibit of works by Chicago artist, Kathy Weaver.

In Weaver's series, *Collateral Damage*, the paintings, and stitched works show the toll of the confrontations of war. The imagery of war machines and robots in her work allows Weaver to express her concerns and despair. The robots are protagonists reflecting the ubiquitous role modern technology plays in 21st century warfare. The victims of these advances are still the citizens, often mothers, children, and the elderly.

Weaver trained at the University of Cincinnati, receiving her M.A. in painting from Bowling Green State University. She has received fellowships at the Banff Centre for the Arts, Ragdale Foundation, Hambidge Center for the Arts, Brush Creek Foundation and has taught at Arrowmont School of Arts and Crafts. She studied in Jogjakarta, Indonesia and at the Institute for European Studies and the Art Academy of Vienna. Her work has been exhibited nationally and internationally. Three quilts in a series, "Guns Are Us", are in the permanent collection of the Museum of Arts and Design in New York City.
